- The package images on the tape are in compressed tar format (see compress(1) and tar(1)). The sysadm utility will automatically uncompress these images when it loads these images.
- GNU software is now delivered via the GNU Toolset product (model R028A).

DGC has included a sample binary installation of this software as the "imagen" package (the source code package is "imagen_src"). You can install this using sysadm's Software -> Package -> Load operation followed by the Software -> Package -> Set up operation. The software will be placed in /usr/opt/imagen. Sample printer databases will be placed in /etc/imagen.db and /etc/imagen.df.
