### Data General Complies With Injunction

Data General has been engaged for some time in antitrust litigation in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California regarding Data General's licensing policies with respect to NOVA operating system software. On July 30, 1986 the court issued a permanent injunction prohibiting Data General from restricting the use of its "NOVA-compatible operating system software" (as that term is defined in the permanent injunction) which includes RDOS operating system software that executes any NOVA instruction set and any operating system software that is an extended or closely related version of RDOS.

It is essential that all Data General employees in the U.S. having customer or potential customer (including competitor) contact understand that:

- The permanent injunction applicable to "NOVA-compatible operating system software" is effective as of July 30, 1986;
- Existing and future licensees of "NOVA-compatible operating system software," are free and privileged to use Data General's "NOVA-compatible operating system software," which includes RDOS, on non-Data General central processing units; and

All existing license agreements are deemed revised to the extent necessary to comply with the permanent injunction.

Customers and potential customers (including competitors) who inquire about the availability of Data General's "NOVA-compatible operating system

software" for use on non-Data General hardware are to be told that Data General will license its "NOVA-compatible operating system software" for use on such non-Data General hardware.

Until the new prices (NOVA hardware and software), policies and forms are announced, printed and distributed, all interested customers and potential customers (including competitors) should be requested to contact Data General's Sales Administration department in Westboro on how to obtain a license and the applicable prices and terms.

Data General is also providing written notice to all of its U.S. customers regarding these matters.

### Data General Enters Into Marketing Agreements

Data General has entered into a pair of marketing agreements with Allen-Bradley Company. Allen-Bradley is a leading supplier of local area networks (LAN) and networking equipment compatible with the Manufacturing Automation Protocol (MAP). One agreement provides for the coordinated marketing of Data General's computer equipment and Allen-Bradley's VistaMAP LAN.

"A user's initial implementation of a MAP network and MAP technologies can be greatly simplified by an arrangement such as this," says Don McDougall, vice president of the Industry Marketing Division. "Both companies provide sound, proven components for the development phase of MAP, as well as a corporate commitment for full MAP implementation.

"Data General also has chosen Allen-Bradley to be a key vendor for broadband and carrier band modems on Data General's MAP interface board, scheduled to become available in 1987," Don says. In addition, the companies will cooperate on MAP broadband design and installation through a contract now under negotiation for the services of Allen-Bradley's Communication Division."

An Independent Hardware Vendor (IHV) agreement with Allen-Bradley allows Data General computer

equipment to run on Allen-Bradley's Data Highway local area network (LAN).

"Through this agreement, users can automate production activities by combining the well-proven technologies of Data General and Allen-Bradley," says Don.

As a result of the agreement, a software interface will enable Data General users to communicate with Allen Bradley's PLC-2 and PLC-3 programmable controller families running on the Data Highway LAN. The interface consists of a software driver and RS-232-C Data Highway interface unit.

Data General will sell and support the software driver, and Allen-Bradley will sell and support the RS-232-C interface unit. Both companies will cooperate on sales opportunities over a wide range of industries.

Allen-Bradley Company, based in Ann Arbor, Mich., reported \$1.2 billion in revenues for fiscal year 1985.

## **New Helicopter Schedule Goes Into Effect**

Starting Monday, September 29, the Data General helicopter will operate on a new schedule, adding the Durham facility to its list of Data General New England plants.

To make flight reservations, call Corporate Travel in Westboro at extension 232-HELI (232-4354). Passengers must be at the helipad five minutes before the scheduled departure time for loading and safety briefing. Unless delayed by weather, flights depart precisely on time Monday through Friday.

Passengers desiring to depart or arrive at Southboro may do so by advising the reservationist. As a result, actual departure or arrival time may be a few minutes after the scheduled time shown for Westboro/Southboro.

## Benefits

### High School Juniors - Apply Now For Scholarship

If you are a regular, full-time Data General employee and have a child who will be graduating from high school in 1988, now is the time to consider applying for a Data General scholarship.

The Data General Scholarship Program is a benefit established for the children of Data General employees and administered by the National Merit Scholarship Corporation. Ten scholarships are awarded each year. The stipend of each scholarship ranges from \$500 to \$2,000 per year for up-to-four years, or until a bachelor's degree requirements are completed, whichever comes first.

#### PSAT Dates

Students applying for a Data General scholarship must take the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT) during their junior year of high school. This year, the test will be administered in high schools throughout the country on October 18 or October 21. Interested students should contact their guidance counselors as soon as possible to register for the PSAT.

Keep in mind that application for a Data General scholarship must be made during the student's JUNIOR year in high school. Therefore, even students who are currently undecided as to whether or not they want to attend college should be encouraged to take the PSAT in October.

Applications for the Data General Scholarship Program are available from the Benefits and Human Resources departments. A letter will be sent to all applicants at the end of December to let them know their entry form was received.

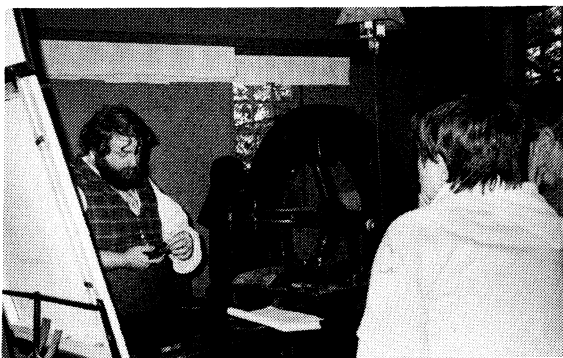

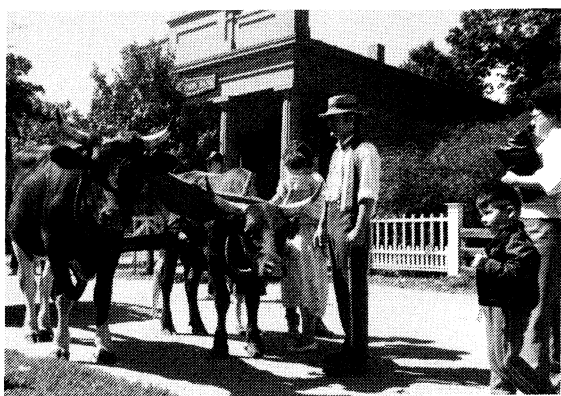
