Situation:

Software Support Package tapes at revisions previous to those listed above do not support D413, D412+ or D400 terminals at baud rates above 4800 baud. These terminals require XON/XOFF protocol support in order to maintain internal buffer integrity. XON/XOFF support has been incorporated into all programs on these latest revision Software Support Package tapes.

System Impact:

Two symptoms may occur when using earlier revision tapes with the above terminals at baud rates higher than 4800 baud:

- 1. When booting the tape, the initial boot menu display may be corrupted and the file loader may begin to search for a file without prior input. File searching is identified by a moving tape as well as ">>>>..." displayed on the terminal.
- 2. Host/terminal communication and/or terminal display may be corrupted when executing the Configurator program.

Action Required:

If you are using a D413, D412+, D400 or any terminal requiring XON/XOFF protocol during data transfer from the host to the terminal: Either configure your serial transfer rate at 4800 baud or lower, or use a Software Support Package tape at the above revision or higher.
